Dr (Mrs.) Shayama Chona, the only school educator who has been awarded the Padma Shri and Padma Bhushan, by the President of India, is the driving force behind the school.

An alumnus of the prestigious Maharani Gayatri Devi Girls' Public School, Dr Chona has broken barriers to change the lives of many. She has launched major initiatives to promote the teaching of Science, Computers and Information Technology in schools. She has been serving as a Member of 97 Advisory Boards and Managing Committees of 68 institutions. Member of Indian National Commission for Cooperation with UNESCO, Member of Governing Body of CBSE, Honorary Advisor in the Education Department of MCD, Member of the National Mission Authority (NMA) of National Mission for Empowerment of Women by the President of India. Her name finds place in the Limca Book of World Records 2007 for being conferred the maximum number of awards. She is also a Member Advisory Board Coca-Cola India Foundation, Member Medanta Independent Ethics Committee, Medanta - The Medicity, Gurgaon. She is also a member of the Stem Cell Committee of Ganga Ram Hospital.

She has given concrete shape to her transcendent principles by setting up 'Autism Center - School of Hope', 'Tamana Special Education Centre' and 'Skill Development Centre - Nai Disha'. As the founder of three schools for children with special needs, she has been working tirelessly since 1984. A proud recipient of 54 awards including the Padma Bhushan, Padma Shri, two National Awards and one State Award, Dr Chona has served society and humanity with distinction and dedication. It is her mission to educate and empower the abled and differently abled that helps her to stand apart. She believes that a child is God's gift to man and needs to be nurtured in an atmosphere of discovery, enquiry, learning, expression and communication.

Our Principal

Dr Ruchi Seth, Principal, is well known in the national and international educational fraternity as a forward-thinking educator, an inspiring team leader, and a school administrator par excellence. Dr Seth has an M.A & M.Ed, with a Ph.D in Psychology from IIT Delhi. 

Curriculum

The Curriculum is characterized by with a unique integration of the best of educational practices from India and abroad. The school follows the curriculum designed by the NCERT & our learners are prepared for the AISSCE (All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination) conducted by the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) for Classes X & XII. The school also offers the Young Learners' English Test (YLE), Key English Test (KET) and Preliminary English Test (PET) conducted by Cambridge International in collaboration with the British Council to further enhance the linguistic skills of learners.

Pre Primary

Primary







Amenities

LVIS offers myriad state-of-the-art amenities and facilities which allow our students to keep in tune with the world, nurture their talent, and cultivate aesthetic values for their holistic development.



Media Centres

The media centres are interactive resource rooms that are more than just libraries. Not only do they house a wide collection of books for all ages, the e-section has a collection of DVDs, videos and on-line learning material. The libraries also have designated areas for individual study and small-group tutorials, with modern conference facilities for larger numbers.





Cafeteria

Our innovatively decorated cafeterias serve healthy and nutritious snacks in hygienic and healthy surroundings. On parental request, lunch is served, keeping in mind the dietary requirements of the growing child. The menu of the meal served to the students is designed by a dietician; it is not only high in nutritional value but also caters to the tastes of our children. There are two cafeterias — one for the primary section that can seat around 100 students and the other for the senior section catering to over 500 students.



Career Counseling

Career counseling is an integral part of our curriculum. Experts are invited to conduct career awareness talks. The counselor conducts aptitude tests, interest checks and holds interactive sessions with students and parents. This helps the learners understand their forte and make an informed choice for a career.

Medical Centre

The school has a tie-up with Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, Sarita Vihar, which monitors the health of our students. The three medical centres are adequately staffed with a full-time doctor from Apollo Hospital, assisted by three qualified, experienced nurses who take care of the general physical well-being of our children and provide immediate first-aid treatment, if needed. Arrangement exists for oxygen cylinder and nebulizer. Medical check-up for height, weight, eye-sight and dental health are conducted on a regular basis. This helps in identifying any problem at the initial stage.



Individualised Care

Personal Counseling

Keeping in mind the developmental needs of the children, and the challenges and adjustment needs of our adolescents, we at Lotus Valley believe in providing psycho-social help to our students. With the aim of seeing happy faces across all 12 acres of our premises, our trained counseling psychologists help the children in their emotional, behavioural, motivational and psychosocial needs. The Counselors also work closely with ORKIDS to cater to children with special needs.

We are an **Inclusive School** and support teachers to include students with diverse needs in the classroom through good inclusive practices —like collaboration, team work, innovative instructional practices, peer-strategies, and more. **Individual Education Plans** are developed for students with special needs where a Psychologist, Special Educators, Operational Therapist, Speech Therapist along with class teachers, subject teachers, and parents work together to ensure that each child is well adjusted and happy, with the aim of maximizing his / her potential.





STEM Education

At Lotus Valley, it is our endeavour to foster in our children the key skills of the 21st century. Every effort is made to provide hands-on learning experiences and facilitate creative, critical thinking and problem solving skills through STEM education. As part of the school's vision to promote STEM education, clubs like Robotics and Astronomy have been introduced. The Robotics Club focuses on basic assembling and programming; the Astronomy Club, in association with SPACE, offers a plethora of exciting activities to help children delve into the wonders of the Universe. The Tinkering Club of the school provides hands-on opportunities in the field of Mechanics, Hydraulics and Electronics to foster innovation skills in students. Students are also taught Graphic & Web Designing, App Development, Coding and JAVA Programming.

During his service he held the high office of Advocate-on-Record in the Supreme Court of India for the State of Punjab from 1987-1989 and Additional Advocate General for the State of Punjab from 1997 till 6th July, 1999. Although retired from service on 7th November, 2007, Justice Sodhi says – "A professional never retires. After retirement I will go back to practices in the Supreme Court."

A former Indian cricketer and Indian national cricket coach, Arjuna Awardee Madan Lal Sharma has been a part of the golden era that changed the face of Indian cricket in the 80s. He holds winning accomplishments of 1983 Prudential World Cup and 1985 Benson


