OTHER HIGHLIGHTS (Achievements across Academics, Innovation, and Sports)

1. Swarit Acharya and Aryavir Singh, both in Grade IX, emerged victorious in the esteemed KVRSS SPARK Innovation Awards organized by the K. V. Rao Scientific Society in Hyderabad on February 3, 2024. Their project, 'DERMAVISION,' clinched the top spot in the final round in the Biology category, KVRSS SPARK JEEVNAM. This accomplishment underscores Lotus Valley's commitment to academic excellence and nurturing young talent. DERMAVISION employs state-of-the-art technology to detect skin conditions, potentially transforming early-stage dermatology accurately. Congratulations to our students on this well-deserved victory! The project has now advanced as a super-finalist for an upcoming event in May- June 2024.
2. In its sincere efforts to provide practical learning experiences, CBSE organized the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC), a national-level competition designed to evaluate analytical, creative, and abstract thinking skills and encourage students to apply Mathematics in their daily lives. Ahaan Duggal and

Ishaan Yadav clinched a prestigious position among the top 100 students nationwide in the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge (AGC) 2023-24! This competition, organized by CBSE, evaluates students' practical application of mathematics in everyday scenarios through two levels of assessment. The initial level, held at the school, was the School Level Competition, while the subsequent round, a National Level Competition, was administered by CBSE as a Computer Test. Ahaan and Ishaan's advancement to the second round speaks volumes about their Mathematical abilities.

3. Pranet Kumar and Shubh Gupta showcased exceptional skills in Computer Science at the International Informatics Olympiad (iiO) organized by the Silverzone Foundation. Pranet Kumar from XI Samuelson secured an outstanding International Rank of 3, earning a Special Certificate, a Bronze Medal, and a cash prize of 5000 rupees. Shubh Gupta, also from XI Samuelson, clinched an impressive International Rank of 22, receiving a Special Certificate, a Bronze Medal, and a cash prize of 400 rupees.
