On Wednesday, Srishti was judged as the winner from among 25 contestants from across the world at the beauty pageant held at Managua, the capital of Nicaragua, a central American country.

Srishti, who hails from Noida, had finished her secondary and higher secondary education from Lotus Valley International School.

Although she pursued humanities in class 12, she made it clear then itself that modelling was her sole passion.

After class 12, she moved to London, along with her parents, to pursue a career in modelling and took admission at the London School of Modelling.

Her dreams came true on Wednesday when she was crowned Miss Teen Universe 2017.
